THE INTERNSHIP

Out & About offers an internship in Therapeutic Recreation, supervised by a Certified Therapeutic Recreation Specialist. The purpose of the internship is to provide students with a professional, educational, and enjoyable internship by offering the opportunity to work with people that have developmental disabilities. The Out & About program is focused on offering quality Therapeutic Recreation services in a community-based setting. As an intern, you may facilitate art, movement, sports activities and much more!

THREE AREAS OF SERVICE

- 1. Catalog Services provide classes and one time events to adults during evenings and weekends. There are also day time classes that happen on weekdays.
- 2. After School Program provides services to school age participants. Students are picked up from school and transported to various community based activities.
- **3. Summer Camp** is a day camp service June through August, featuring full days of activities for school age participants.

- Possess a current driver's license, clean driving record, and personal health insurance
- Maintain professional communication with staff, volunteers, participants, families and providers
- Obtained or seeking degree in therapeutic recreation or recreation management
