




TYPICAL WORK WEEK

- 35 - 40 hours a week
- Lead 1 - 2 van trips a week
 - Hikes, shopping trips, whitewater rafting, rodeo, etc...
- Work in the rec office
 - Selling merchandise, signing people up for trips, renting out camping gear, CLEANING!
- Supervise on-location activities
 - Pickup athletic games, league softball, movie nights, bingo, pool tourneys



PROS AND CONS

- PROS
- Living and working in Yellowstone!
 - Access to park info
 - Serving employees - not park visitors
 - Limited access to internet/wi-fi (get into the backcountry!)

- CONS
- Dorm living / employee dining room
 - Long varied hours
 - Limited access to internet/wi-fi



POSITIONS

- Two positions : Supervisor and Coordinator
- Supervisor is in charge of their location.
- Supervisor season is mid-April - mid-October
- There are 2 - 3 coordinators at each location. They facilitate activities and assist the Supervisors
- Coordinators' seasons range from early to late May and could end early August through mid-September.
- 2019 wages:
 - Supervisor - \$11.60/hr
 - Coordinator - \$10.25/hr
